We are currently forming our 2019 Spring/Summer USTA and CTA leagues. If you had a team that played out of Meadow Creek last year, you will get registration priority. The CTA & USTA made a few changes for the upcoming season. Notably, play-days for some levels have changed in a number of leagues. Highlighted in red below are the changes. If your level is in black, or the league is not listed below, the day of the week you play remains the same as 2018. The changes are as follows:

Coman Tiebreak Procedure Change

The Coman tiebreak procedure will no longer be used for any league matches in Colorado. Instead, all set tiebreaks and match tiebreaks in local leagues and district championship matches will be played using the standard tiebreak (play 6 points on a side and then switch sides, all the other rules remain the same.) The Coman tiebreak will still be in effect at Sectional and National Championships, however.

New "Plus" Divisions Added to CTA Leagues

Straight NTRP "CTA" leagues will now offer "plus levels." The highest offered NTRP level at District Championships will be designated as the plus (+) NTRP level. This can differ for the men's & women's divisions. Since all CTA leagues are 3-line leagues, teams participating in designated plus (+) divisions will be able to have two players on their roster from the next higher NTRP rating level (only one can play in each team match). Adding plus (+) divisions will give players the opportunity to play in leagues they would otherwise be excluded from.

Seeding for Final Rounds at District Championships

Consistent with USTA National, Semi-final rounds at District Championship events will now be seeded. The match ups for the semi-final rounds will be as follows: 1 vs 4 and 2 vs 3. League seeding will only take place at semi-final rounds of District Championships. In situations where a wildcard team advances to the semis, it is possible that teams from the same flight could play each other again in the semis.

ITA Mixed Rescheduling of Matches Change

Teams participating in ITA Mixed matches will no longer be able to request to reschedule their match due to a league championship conflict. This change is only for the ITA Mixed League since the majority of the league season takes place on dates with league championship events. Since ITA Mixed matches are played on Sunday at 12pm and 3pm, this should minimally affect players playing in league championships.
